MANATEE BASICS FOR BOATERS

OBEDIENT POSTED SIGNS

Regulatory Waterway Signs

Fines and legal penalties may apply



Lowest speed needed to maintain steering. MiraBay: All canals and lagoon



Boat settled in the water
Not plowing or pushing water
Minimum wake behind vessel.



Diamond with an X shows no entry
Example: TECO's Big Bend power plant.



Indicates the end of a regulatory zone.

Informational Waterway Signs

Designed for your safety



Danger Signs

All diamond shaped signs indicate a hazard to navigation. Beware.



Caution Signs

Caution signs are square and advise boaters of potential problems or important resources.



Awareness Signs

Available from Save the Manatee Club and can be posted on your dock or seawall.

Boater Education Law

Anyone 21 years old or younger is required to take a boater education course to operate a vessel with a motor of 10 horsepower or higher in Florida's public waters.

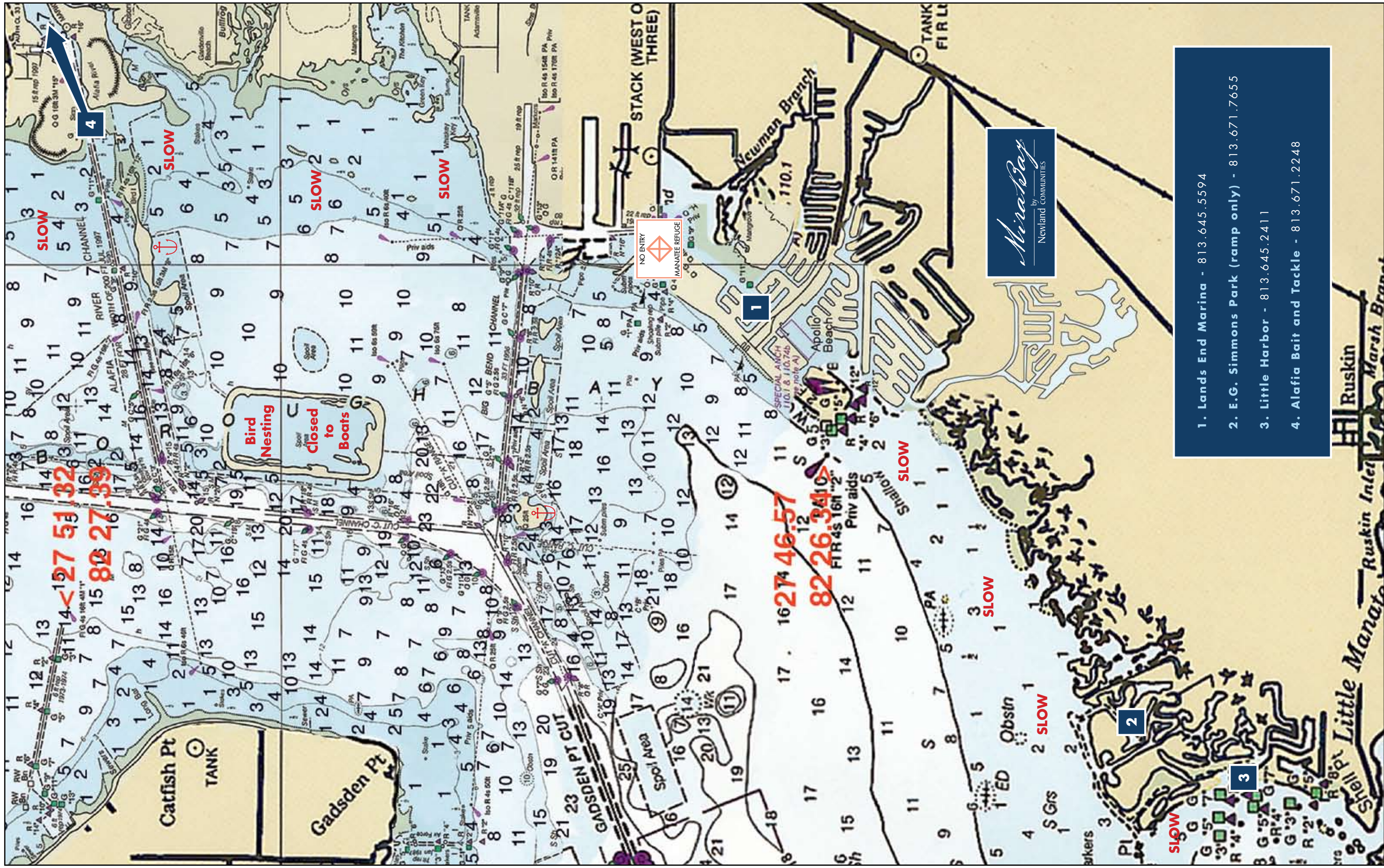
